

In this edition of the Luxe Report, The Leading Hotels of the World (LHW) is thrilled to share the evidence of extraordinary growth within the travel and hospitality industry.

LHW is on pace for a historic revenue year, tracking 105% above 2021 YTD. Pent up demand for travel, coupled with the removal of travel restrictions, has resulted in this strong performance and an even better on the books outlook for the rest of 2022.

Some trends to pay attention to during the transition to autumn:

Consumers continue to 'trade up' when traveling. LHW's suite and villa bookings are 36% above 2019 levels. The desire for more space and privacy brought on by the pandemic remains a persistent trend in 2022. Even with inflation and recession forecasts looming, occupancy and room rates are on the rise. Today, LHW's average daily rate (ADR) is 40% above 2019.

International travel has returned, but not at the expense of domestic travel. US travel to Europe is up approximately 225% YOY and flat to 2019. Still, the US, and several European countries including Switzerland and Italy continue to experience comparatively high levels of domestic travel as compared to 2019.

Travelers have a renewed interest in city destinations. LHW's metropolitan properties, which were disproportionally affected by the pandemic, have seen a 100% increase in revenue since 2021. With a 50/50 mix of city and resort member hotels, LHW continues to drive growth with its passionate hoteliers to its beloved city properties.

LHW's booking revenue has outpaced even 2019 levels each week from February 2022 onward. And in line, LHW's consumed and on the books business for the year is up 14% over 2019.

Our Company's record-breaking performance in 2022, despite the economic headwinds that loom, is encouraging. I am confident that the industry and LHW are poised for success in the last quarter of the year and a strong 2023.

Where To Next

International travel continues its momentous return, particularly with US travelers to Europe. Italy has consistently held the #1 most popular location for bookings in 2022 and now into the fall. Following Italy, the US, France, Switzerland, and Spain have shifted positioning within the top five spots seasonally and continue their stronghold in this next quarter. Additionally, the popular resort-based market of Turks & Caicos has drawn LHW travelers in 2021 and throughout 2022 as one of the first markets to outperform their 2019 record results.

LHW Top Origin/ Destination Pairs

2022 has brought a rebound of international travel. US travel to Europe is up approximately +225% YOY and flat to 2019. However, this is not at the expense of domestic travel, which continues to be strong within countries such as the United States, Switzerland and Italy.

LHW Suite Mix

The trend toward a greater proportion of reservations being made for a suite/villa versus other room types is persisting. In 2019, 18% of bookings made were for a suite/villa room type versus 30% of 2022 bookings to date. As concerns about the pandemic decrease for some travelers, and some business travel returns, the mix may be slowly returning to traditional room type mix. That said, many travelers have built up and saved for 'big' trips in 2022 which may help explain the continued interest in suites and villas still so far this year.

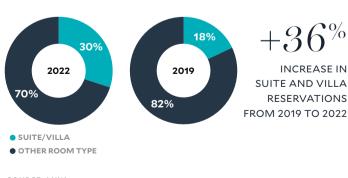
